This packet of information provides an overview of the Accessibility Project and is designed to help you determine your part in the project. At our Church Conference in October 2014, the congregation voted to explore an Accessibility Project that would replace the deteriorating concrete bridge at the entrance to our church with a smaller one. This project would also include a small addition with an elevator. During May, we are conducting a Pledge Campaign to help us formulate a financial plan for this project.

This packet of information includes a description of the project along with a picture and floor plan of the proposed renovation. The Accessibility Project brochure details the history of this project as well as next steps. To assist you in deciding how you want to contribute to this project, we have included a spiritual guide that can be used as a daily devotional for the two weeks between the project kick-off (May 3) and the presentation of pledges (May 17). We have also included a guide with practical information to assist you in decision making, along with a pledge card and a privacy envelope. On May 17, pledge cards will be collected during worship.

If you have questions about the project, cottage meetings will be held between May 4 and 9. The brochure in this packet includes more information about the cottage meetings and also includes contact information for people who have been involved with the planning and are willing to answer questions about the project.
